A MINI WORKSHOP THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 7:00-9:00 FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 10:00-4:00 GREAT HALL, third floor SUMMIT ARTSPACE **Patrick Lee** returns to Akron to teach a mini-workshop sharing his approach to painting the human figure in conjunction with judging Akron Society of Artists' 89th Annual Member Show.

This workshop will include a Thursday evening demonstration and a Friday painting class. A maximum of eight participants will paint from two clothed models Friday morning, then in the afternoon, instruction will be offered on how to personalize the morning efforts.

Attendees will practice clarifying their vision and purpose by learning to ask questions such as:

- -What is it about this person that I want to capture in my painting?
- -What qualities do I want the painting to have that will best engender my initial intent?
- -What feeling do I want the final piece to convey?

This questioning process will reveal ways to transform visual



observations into authentic, artistic expressions of feelings, thoughts, and form.

Although instruction will be in oil, other media are welcome.

Our venue is amply large to accommodate eight students divided among two models, observing county Covid regulations. Masks are required for artists and models, when not posing.

Patrick Lee(American painter, b. 1972)

received his BFA from Edinboro University of Pennsylvania in 1996. Since then, he has shown extensively in group and solo exhibitions, as well as won awards at national plein air competitions.

Patrick takes a unique creative approach to making paintings in the studio and en plein



air. He draws heavily on intuition and imagination to develop an image, often altering the drawing, color, and spatial relationships to create a mood and express a feeling about the subject. This often leads to strong elements of abstraction and suggestion in his work, rather than explicit detail. This gives the viewer an opportunity to connect with each piece in their own way, inviting them to let their own imaginations make personal associations and connections.

ASA is thrilled to bring this talented artist back to Akron.
